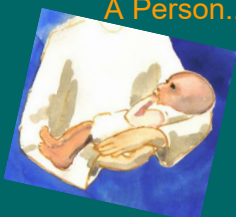
Nativity Trail

Christmas Light Show You will notice the city has been decorated with Christmas trees and lights. You can also watch a simple Christmas light show projected on the side of a building in Ward Road in Dundee city centre each evening **4:00pm - 8:00pm from 1st to 24th December.**

Carol Service There are many Christmas songs we love to sing at Christmas - some very old and some new. We'll join together on Zoom to sing these songs on **Wednesday 2nd December**. The Dundee Christian Unions have created this event.

Christmas Crafts At the International Café on Zoom, **5th Dec. 8:00pm** we'll share with you how to make an advent calendar, Christmas decorations and treats.

Dundee Nativity There is a long tradition of children acting out the story of Christmas. In Dundee each year a play is written and produced as a community event. This year it has not been possible to present the play to a live audience, but it will be available as a video to view online **from 11th December**. We shall provide a link on our app and social media.

Nativity Trail People around Dundee are busy preparing scenes from the Christmas story to display in their front gardens or in the windows of their houses. We'll provide information so you can follow the trail on **Saturday 12th December** around Dundee and find these window displays. We can provide someone who knows the city well to guide you to each place (with social distancing). We hope this will be a fun-filled outdoor activity rather like a treasure hunt game.
